## Describing people:



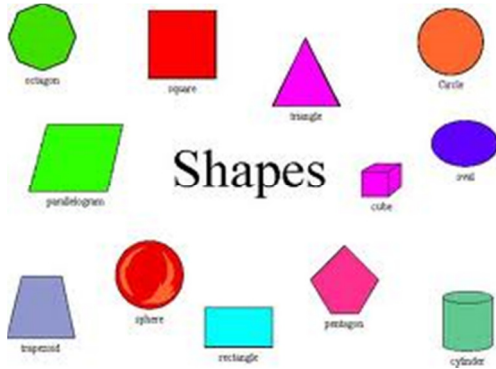
- Is it a man or a woman / a boy or a girl?
- Does he/she have a name?
- Does he/she have a sign name?
- How tall is he/she? Indicate height. If very tall or very small you might give measurement.
- Is he/she fat, slim, medium build, plump, muscled?
- Is he/she young, middle aged, old? Specific age?
- What the hair style like?                      What is the colour of the hair?  
Straight, long, short, curly,                      Blonde, red, black, brown, grey,  
wavy, perm, highlights /                      white  
dyed, plaited, bun, pony-tail;  
cropped, shaved, bald
- Does he/she wear glasses?                      What is the colour of the eyes?
- Is he/she deaf or hearing?                      Wears hearing aids or cochlea  
Deaf, deafened, hard of                      implants?  
hearing

### *Facial features:-*

- Is she pretty / beautiful / ugly?                      Is he handsome or ugly?
- Does he/she have freckles, spots/spotty, mole(s), dimple(s)?
- Smiley or sad looking?
- Beard or moustache?
- Any other features?

# Describing

## Describing objects:



- Shape – square, round, triangle, cube, long, short, box, ball, etc.
- Size / Weight – big, huge, small (various ways of doing this), medium, light, heavy, etc.
- Colour – use base colours plus light / dark, mix of colours.
- Patterns – stripes (narrow / wide / variable), checked, spots (large, medium, small), flowers (as for spots), other regular patterns, random.
- Texture – smooth, rough, bumpy, clean, very clean, not clean, shiny, dull, dirty, rough, etc.

Think of an object and describe it to others and see if they can guess what it is:-

Describe the shape of the object, size (use NMF for this), colour, patterns, weight – light or heavy (use NMF for this), texture – smooth, rough; etc., etc.

You could also describe the motion of the object:-

Ball – holding the ball... the ball bouncing... hitting the wall.
