

For 311 (receptive)

Example:-

If a candidate is watching a video clip/discussion in BSL and does not understand a sign, they should find out what this sign means. They could do this by:

- using various websites
- using reference books for example Dictionary of British Sign Language
- using DVDs, video tapes
- asking role models – Deaf people, Deaf presenters on TV, Teachers, Assessors, Internal Verifiers
- asking other people who have Level 3 or above – peers, communicators, interpreters.

The candidate should show the reference source they have used in their portfolio and include it on the assessment and feedback record sheet or in a personal statement.

For 312 (productive)

Example:-

If the candidate is planning a conversation on health procedures and needs to learn a new sign to present information they could:

- use various websites
- use reference books for example Dictionary of British Sign Language
- use DVDs, video tapes (there are old ones about)
- ask role models – Deaf people, Deaf presenters on TV, Teachers, Assessors, Internal Verifiers
- ask other people who have Level 3 or above – peers, communicators, interpreters.

The candidate should show the reference source they have used in their portfolio and include it on the assessment and feedback record sheet or in a personal statement.
