

Signs in context (advance)

Just:

I have just done that
It was just a game
He used just enough salt
She just caught the bus before it pulled away
This job is just about done
This is a just account
That's just what I mean
He received his just reward

Gravity:

The gravity of the event was not something to laugh about
They are still quite unaware of the gravity of their problems.
The apple always falls to the ground because of gravity
The gravity of his manner earn him deep respect

Good time:

We had a good time at the party
The train arrived in good time

Degree:

I have a degree in Deaf Studies
I am quite ill, my temperature is 100°

Finish:

I have finished my homework
The relationship is finished
Have you all done your tasks?
Have you all finished?
Study time is now over

Clue:

Give me a clue
I don't have a clue

Last:

Last night, last year, last week
I was the last one in
I was the last in the queue
This will last for a long time
At last the bus arrived
Last man standing
Last one left

Find:

Can you help me find my keys please
I will find it for you

Building / build:

Put up a building
Building my confidence
I am building up my portfolio

Back:

Get back to work
I am back home now
I drove to London and back
My back is bothering me again
I always back up my computer files
(see extended list for 'Back')

Copy: (highly directional and locational, and used in many situations so you would need to think carefully how this is done)
Many books and DVDs have a copy right to them

Break:

I am taking a career break
Some things can break quite easily
I still work on whilst having a coffee break

Vice:

What are your vices?
The vice-chair gave a long speech
The vice hold the metal piece firmly

Workshop:

The chair is being repaired in the workshop
I sometimes go to a workshop to improve my signing

Skills:

He is very skillful at linguistics
His signing skills were excellent
She is very skillful with her driving

Change:

The shop assistant gave me some change from the £5 note
I change my clothes quite often
Sometimes I like to go out for a walk for a change
Occasionally I have to make changes to my teaching plans

Use:

I use the computer a lot
I find it very useful to learn these
I am used to it!
I used to cycle to work
